A Message From Our Board President and Executive Director

Sometimes, in order to fully appreciate an organization, it's beneficial to consider what life might be like without it. Just Imagine our island's more than 100 nonprofits working diligently to improve the quality of life here without the Community Foundation for Nantucket. Had a small group of dedicated and visionary people not created the Community Foundation for Nantucket twenty years ago, some of those organizations might not exist today. Others might not be thriving and, most certainly, the quality of life on Nantucket would not be the same. In that span, CFN has granted over \$42M through all its funds to benefit housing, healthcare, food security, childcare, elder care, and scholarships. No other organization on our island serves this breadth of Nantucket's needs.

The generosity of our island was never more evident, nor more vital, than in 2025. Our 20th anniversary was remarkable and historic. Through the Nantucket Fund, our discretionary grantmaking process, we awarded \$1,000,000 to nonprofits across the Island, including four Community Impact grants totaling \$380,000 which were intended to be transformative for those nonprofits. More broadly, the Foundation continues to be Nantucket's home for informed, effective philanthropy. In 2025, we managed more than 100 charitable funds—including donor-advised funds, scholarships, and community-led initiatives that collectively granted over \$4.6 million to causes that matter. We also have been at the forefront of convening community discussions searching for solutions to our island's most pressing problems.

As we look ahead to 2026, we are committed to maintaining that same level of philanthropy. We work meticulously to become informed about the needs of Nantucket, and then to connect our donors to their passions so that we can all contribute to improving the lives of everyone who calls Nantucket home. This can only happen with your help.

THE NANTUCKET FUND AWARDED \$1M IN GRANTS

Thanks to your generous support, 2025 was a year of meaningful progress and increased impact for the Community Foundation for Nantucket. Here is how your donations were invested in our island community.

Community Investment Grants

In 2025, the Community Foundation's board voted to support four critical initiatives in response to urgent needs in areas of behavioral health, childcare, food insecurity, and housing as identified by its Advisory Committee, nonprofit partners, and other stakeholders. These impactful grants totaled \$380,000 to the community, the largest single grants CFN has ever distributed through The Nantucket Fund:

- **Nantucket Boys and Girls Club** to expand access to preschool for Nantucket children
- **Fairwinds, Nantucket's Counseling Center** to strengthen the sustainability of the island's primary counseling center
- **Nantucket Food, Fuel and Rental Assistance** to help secure a more permanent location for the island's only Food Pantry
- **Nantucket Food, Fuel and Rental Assistance** to support the rental and fuel assistance program

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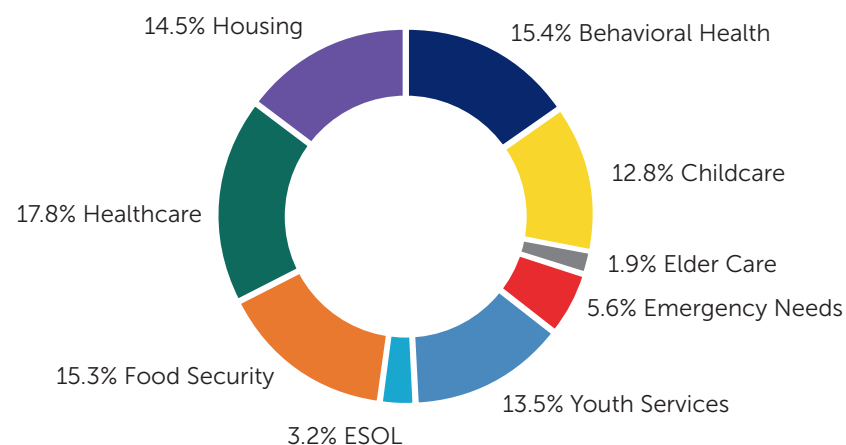

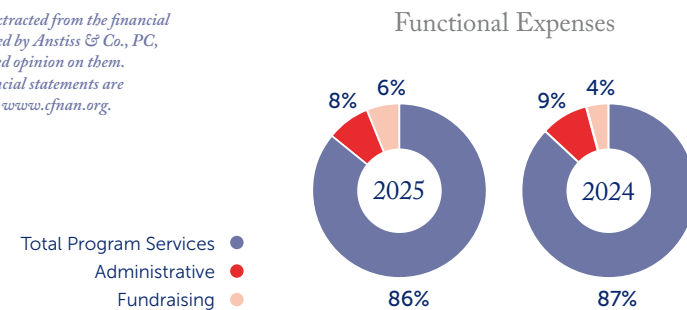
